November 18<sup>th</sup> was the day of the "Bless Chiang Mai" city-wide prayer event. About 3,000 Thai Christians joined together to pray and worship at the Tha Pae Gate. This was the second year that we were able to coordinate the children's prayer event and it was very encouraging to see the Thai leaders step-up and run with many aspects of the event.

This year the theme was based on the Lord's Prayer. We were able to distribute some [prayer activity sheets](#) to around 1,000 children at the various churches.

CBN helped us with a clip for a promo video.

The event included games, workshops, worship and prayer. Workshops included:

- Thai dance to a Thai song of the Lord's Prayer
- Sign language to the song "As it is in heaven" by Michael W. Smith.
- Prophetic art
- Lord's Prayer spinner craft activity



There was prayer for the King of Thailand, the Prime Minister and the government and also for the many affected by the flooding.

We interviewed Miriam Sornprommas, a fashion model. Miriam shared how she had prayed that God would help her pursue her dream of attending an international school. She had never imagined that God would answer her prayer by opening up this opportunity to be able to fund her own education. The children prayed for Miriam and that she would be a good influence in the fashion industry. Miriam prayed for the children that God would lead them into the great future that He has for them.

We finished by praying for God's Kingdom to come in Thailand as it is in heaven.

### Hoay Maw



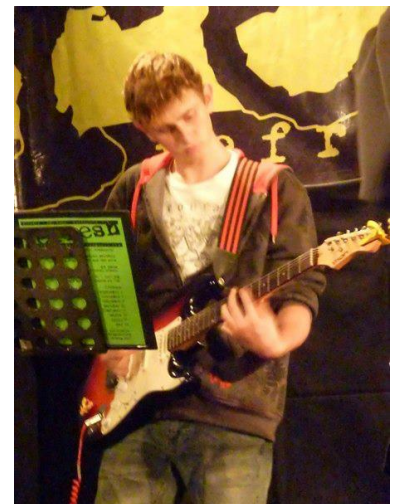
